# **Assignment 3**

Which information do you need from Radio Medical Denmark before you may give an injection?



when you break open a glass ampoule, make sure the tip is empty, and no medicine remains in tip.

Place an unopened alcohol swap between your finger and the glass ampoule, to avoid cutting your fingers.



With medicine chest A and B you may find 3 different sizes of syringes:

E.7- 2 ml; E.8 – 5 ml; E.10 – 10 ml

You only carry one size needle in the Danish medicine chest: *E*.6

# First aid – in case you hit yourself with a contaminated needle:

- **1.** Let it bleed for a few moments.
- **2.** Wash thoroughly with soap and water.
- **3.** Disinfect with 11.1 Chloride Hexidine 0.5/85 %

Disinfect twice, allow drying between applications.

Contact Radio Medical Denmark for risk- assessment and possible further actions.

# Remember

Approximately 20 % of the medicine in the medicine chest is something you need to give as an injection.

### **Assignment 1**

Which questions do you need to ask the patient before Radio Medical Denmark prescribes medicine?

You have to ask the patient, if he has any allergies or if he takes any medicine.

### **Assignment 2**

Please, list the 3 types of injections that Radio Medical Denmark may ask you to perform:

- Subcutaneously- under the skin.
- Intramuscularly /into the muscle.
- Intravenously into the vein.

### **Assignment 3**

Which information do you need from Radio Medical Denmark before you may give an injection?

You need:

- 1. Name and number of medicine.
- 2. Concentration (mg/ml).
- 3. Total amount (mg).
- 4. How/where to inject.

### Assignment 4

What is the most significant difference between how to give a intramuscular injection and how to give a subcutaneous injection?

Give the **intramuscular** injection at a 90<sup>0</sup> angle, into the muscle.

Give the **Subcutaneous** injection at an angle, of no more than  $30^{0}$  into a skin fold.
