*Order no. 1524 of 8 December 2016
issued by the Danish Maritime Authority*

Order on the reporting of persons working on board ships registered in the Danish International Register of Shipping

In pursuance of section 64b(2) and section 70(1) of the act on seafarers' conditions of employment, etc. (*søfarendes ansættelsesforhold m.v.*), cf. consolidated act no. 73 of 17 January 2014, the following provisions are laid down:

Reporting of persons

Section 1. The owner of the ship shall ensure that, once a year, reporting is made on persons on board ships registered in the Danish International Register of Shipping.

Subsection 2. The reporting shall contain the information listed in the manning forms printed in the annex.

Section 2. The reporting shall be forwarded to the Danish Shipowners' Association once a year on a date decided by the Danish Maritime Authority.

Subsection 2. In case of changes of the manning on the date concerned, the shipowner shall determine another date of reporting so as to achieve a true picture of ships' manning.

Penalty provisions

Section 3. Contraventions of section 1 shall be liable to punishment by fine.

Subsection 2. Companies, etc. (legal entities) may be liable to punishment pursuant to the provisions of part 5 of the penal code (*straffeloven*).

Entry into force, etc.

Section 4. This order shall enter into force on 1 January 2017.

Section 5. This order shall not apply to Greenland and the Faroe Islands.
