This form must be used when a ship is deleted by the Register of Shipping due to transfer of ownership, which is not considered as Danish as in section 1, sub-sections 2-3 of the [Danish] Merchant Shipping Act.

Danish is defined as:

- Danish citizens.
- Danish government institutions and local authorities.
- Legal persons, who are established under Danish legislation or registered as Danish companies, foundations or associations here in Denmark.
- Jointly owned shipping companies are considered as Danish, if at least half of the the
 jointly owned shipping company is owned by natural or legal persons covered by
 paragraphs 1-3 and the Managing Shipowner complies with the conditions in
 paragraph 1-3.
- In certain situations, when the applicant or the Register of Shipping assesses that it is not clear that the new owner is not Danish due to certain factors, then documentation must be provided.

For natural persons, a copy of the passport, identity card or similar must be submitted. For legal persons, a print of the country's Central Business Register or similar must be attached.

A copy of the ship deed, bill of sale or similar must be signed by the Seller and enclosed.
