Decision *

Ships registered under the Danish flag that transport persons according to notice 722 of 08/03/2017 to and from windfarm installations at sea, may carry medicine and medical equipment according to Supplement list W in addition to the medicine and medical equipment required in Notice A chapter IX B.

The Supplement W is a list of medicine and medical equipment, prepared by the Danish Maritime Authority in cooperation with the Maritime industry.

In order to carry the supplement W, all crewmembers on board must complete a special course in medical care approved by the Danish Maritime Authority in accordance with the inventory of medicine and medical equipment carried

The course must be refreshed at least every 5 years

The course meets the requirements for the basic and refresher course category C.

The course meets the requirement for refresher course category B.

Certificates are automatically renewed to the above categories.

It is the responsible of Danish Shipping to convene the Maritime industry and the Danish Maritime Authority for evaluation of the scheme at least every two years

All previous exemption, on medicine and medical equipment, on the above mentioned types of vessels are revoked.

The decision will enter into force on 01.04.2019
