*Order no. 916 of 23 of June 2023
issued by the Danish Maritime Authority*

Order on the Derogation of Qualification Requirements and Crew Regulations Pursuant to the Act on the Manning of Ships

Pursuant to Section 18(2)(2)(a-d) of the Act on the Manning of Ships, cf. Consolidation Act No. 74 of 17 January 2014, and Section 18(2)(2)(a-d) of Executive Order No. 608 of 25 June 2001 on the Entry into Force for Greenland of the Act on the Manning of Ships, the following is hereby decreed:

Section 1. The Danish Maritime Authority may, pursuant to Section 5(2) of the Act on the Manning of Ships and the Executive Order on the Entry into Force for Greenland of the Act on the Manning of Ships, after a specific assessment, increase or decrease the qualification requirements and crewing regulations set out in Section 6(2) of the Act on the Manning of Ships and Section 6(1) of the Executive Order on the Entry into Force for Greenland of the Act on the Manning of Ships in the following cases:

- 1) Trading outside defined Danish near-coastal waters under conditions similar to near-coastal voyages in Danish waters, but within the defined near-coastal waters of another Party to the STCW Convention on the condition that an undertaking between the two Parties has been entered, specifying the details of both the involved trading areas and other relevant conditions in accordance with Regulation I/3 of the STCW Convention.
- 2) For passenger ships and tankers, taking into account the ship's design, equipment, trading area, and number of passengers.
- 3) For voyages on ships with special maneuvering capabilities.
- 4) For voyages on ships which are constructed, fitted, or equipped for special purposes
- 5) For voyages on ships of special construction.

Section 2. Section 1, No. 1 of this Order does not apply to Greenland.

Section 3. The Order enters into force on 1 July 2023.
