The Gulf of Guinea

The Danish Defence Command has continuously monitored and assessed the situation in the Gulf of Guinea, and there have been no significant changes in the area for maritime traffic since the most recent OXXO message issued in December 2023. The Danish Defence Command therefore recommends maintaining MARSEC 2 for the mentioned area.

Update on ISPS Security Level for the Gulf of Guinea.

On December 16, 2021, the National ISPS Coordination Committee issued an OXXO message maintaining MARSEC 2.

Based on available information and the threat of piracy at sea, Danish authorities confirm their assessment of MARSEC 2 for the Gulf of Guinea.

The ISPS MARSEC 2 risk area in the Gulf of Guinea (excluding ports) is within the following zone:

- 1. 06°07′00"N 001°13′00"E (Lomé, Togo) to
- 2. 02°47′00"N 001°13′00"E to
- 3. 01°01′00″N 005°00′00″E to
- 4. 01°01′00"N 009°32′00"E (Equatorial Guinea).
