Order no. 1494 of 21 of November 2023 issued by the Danish Maritime Authority

Order amending the Order on the counting and registration of persons on board passenger ships operating to and from ports in the Member States of the Community

Section 1

In Order No. 1235 of 28 November 2019 on the counting and registration of persons on board passenger ships operating to and from ports in the Member States of the Community, the following amendments are made:

1. Section 3, subsection 2, is amended as follows:

"Subsection 2. The number of persons on board must, prior to departure from port, be communicated to the company's registration officer or to the shore-based system belonging to the company, from which it can be made available to the designated authority at any time without difficulty."

- **2.** Section 3, subsection 3, is repealed.
- **3.** Section 5, subsection 2, is amended as follows:

"Subsection 2. The registered information mentioned in subsection 1 must be communicated to the company's registration officer or to the shore-based system belonging to the company no later than 15 minutes after the ship's departure, from which it can be made available to the designated authority at any time without difficulty."

- **4.** Section 5, subsection 3, is repealed.
- **5.** Section 6, subsection 2, is amended as follows:

"Subsection 2. Shipping companies whose passenger ships fly the flag of a third country must ensure that the information mentioned in Section 3, subsection 1, and Section 5, subsection 1, is collected and made available to the designated Danish authority when the ships depart from a port outside the Community to sail to a Danish port."

Section 2

This Order shall enter into force on 21 December 2023.
