*Order no. 198 of 27 February 2017
issued by the Danish Maritime Authority*

**Order for the Faroe Islands on a special liability limit for ships below 300 tonnes
for claims other than claims related to personal injury or deaths**

In pursuance of section 175(6), the second sentence, of the merchant shipping act (*søloven*), as enacted for the Faroe Islands by royal decree no. 187 of 8 February 2017, the following provisions are laid down by authority:

Section 1. The liability limit stipulated in section 175(3) of the merchant shipping act (*søloven*), as enacted for the Faroe Islands by royal decree no. 187 of 8 February 2017, shall be set at:

- 1) 775,000 SDR for ships with a gross tonnage of and below 100 tonnes; and
- 2) 1 million SDR for ships with a gross tonnage from 101 to 299 tonnes.

Section 2. This order shall enter into force on 1 March 2017.
