## **Order amending the order on the rights of ship passengers**

### **Section 1**

In order no. 74 of 29 January 2013 on the rights of ship passengers, the following amendments shall be made:

1. The following shall be inserted as a *footnote* to the title of the order:

“1) Pursuant to article 288 of the TFEU Treaty, a regulation shall be directly applicable in all member States. This order contains provisions relating to the use in this country of regulation (EU) no. 1177/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 November 2010 concerning the rights of passengers when travelling by sea and inland waterway and amending regulation (EC) no. 2006/2004, Official Journal 2010, no. L 334, pp. 1-16.”

2. *Section 5* shall be as follows:

“**Section 5.** Anyone, including carriers, tour operators, travel agents and ticket vendors, contravening the regulation shall be liable to punishment by fine.

*Subsection 2.* The Danish Maritime Authority may order anyone, including carriers, tour operators, travel agents and ticket vendors, contravening the regulation to remedy the non-conformance immediately or within a stipulated deadline.”

### **Section 2**

This order shall enter into force on 12 January 2015.
